Rick calls the meeting to order and asks Kevin to go ahead and address the Commission.

Kevin mentions they want to use the airport again for the Balloon Fest. Kevin asks if the Commission would pay for the porta potties and dumpster again this year like the past several years. Kevin also said if they get the invoice again for the dumpster and they have the money, they'll go ahead and pay it, but it's set up for the invoice to come to the airport. Rick asks Kevin how many balloons he thought would be here. Kevin said there should be ten this year. Kevin mentions a couple churches running shuttle vans like the past few years. Kevin also mentions a pecan/cashew vendor wanting to come out to the airport for the Balloon Fest and Scott mentions Jody Allen, that was at the car show wants to come back during the fest.

Scott mentions then, the're nine regular porta potties, one handicap, one wash station and a six yard dumpster and Kevin confirmed. Kevin thanked the Commission for their time and excused himself.

Jim Schwerman is also present and Rick asks Jim to give his crop update. Jim said all the beans had been sold and that we still had three-hundred bushel of corn he wished he had sold. The average price per bushel for what corn has been sold is \$6.81 and the price that day was at \$5.10. Jim said we have till the end of September for the price to recover. Jim also said he had sold 2,000 bushel of wheat at \$6.98 and that we still hand 2,846 bushel left to sell. Jim mentions sending several files to the auditors that they had requested from Steve and that they mentioned the contract with the airport is old and even thou it carries over every year, it would be a good idea to sign a new one. Jim said he had a new one for us to look over that would be good thru the rest of this year and all of next year. Jim also said he thought it would be a good idea to review and sign a new contract every year even thou there has never been an issue.

Jim passed copies out to each commissioner to look over. Jim went over the whole contract, explaining everything. A short discussion ensued on the contract. Jim also explained how the airports money is kept in the trust department so they give us the highest rate they can give us with money market accounts. Rick ask that all in favor of continuing the farm agreement to signify by saying aye and all apposed by saying nay. Rick and Jim both signed the new contract and agreed that we look at it again in November of 2024. Jim thanked us for our time and excused himself.

The minutes were read by all. Walt made a motion to approve the minutes. It was second by John and was approved by all saying aye.

The Treasurer's report was read by all. Walt made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. It was second by Paul and approved by all saying aye.

Steve said he had called Facer Insurance for a quote to double our coverage on all buildings, because of increases they were insured for half of replacement cost. The previous years premium was \$6400 and the new premium is \$14,359. Some discussion ensued. Walt made a motion to increase our property insurance and John second it. It was approved by all saying aye.

Walt makes a motion to accept the bills as presented. John second it and it was approved by all saying aye.

Managers Report

Scott said he had gone to Oshkosh air show and had found the Higher Power Doors, the same people that John had talk to about hangar doors. Scott asks for a quote on six doors. Scott went over what all was quoted and what extra we would have to purchase locally, (steel skin), plus installation. A lengthy discussion ensued on new hangar doors. Rick agreed to submit a proposal to the county board on the upcoming Thursday evening and Carol would get it to Jessica to be put on the agenda.

Scott mentions needing to address two hangar renters that haven't had the aircraft out of the hangar in a very long time. One is Keith Harshman who has a health issue and is going to sell his plane. The other one is Jeff Crane who bought a Challenger almost three years ago and has not taken one flying lesson. We're basically just storing his aircraft for him. Keith is in hangar number 12 and Jeff is in hangar number 6. Also Don Kroenlein's airplane hasn't been flown for awhile but he has three airplanes. One here at the airport and two at his home. Steve said that Don's purchased over \$1600 worth of fuel this year which is more than any other renter. Rick read an old eviction letter and said he could have new ones ready to be mailed out that week if everyone was in agreement. A short discussion ensued and it was agreed that Rick send the two letters out. Carol said there's still three million dollars of the ARPA money left and explained to Rick what all he needed to show in our submittal. A lengthy discussion ensued on what the total cost of six doors would come to. A \$240.000 figure was arrived at for Rick to submit.

Scott also mentioned that while at the Oshkosh air show he was presented with a plaque of an EAA chapter that used to be here at Shelbyville from 1984 to 1990. Scott inquired as to what needed to be done to make the chapter active again. Scott said he was going to try and revitalize Chapter 814 here at Shelbyville and make it active again. Scott mentioned having a lot of interest in started our own chapter and we would still work with the Decatur chapter as far as flying young eagles and such. This chapter would be more on the maintenance side of aviation. Such as projects of putting airplanes back together.

Scott also mentions that Paul is still working on the Main Hangar roof and since it was power washed it leaks in several spot. You can't see them from up on top, only pin holes from looking from inside. Paul said he was just going to apply the paint heavier on the seams and see how many leaks stop.

Scott said he has received a couple hundred dollar ramp fees from the crop dusters.

Rick asks John if he got reimbursed for his car show fees. Steve said we lost money on the car show but he felt it was worth it.

Rick also mentions a letter from IDOT about a letting on the hangar rehabilitation and talking to Lindsay about it Rick played a voice mail from Lindsay and she talk about the funding time line and maybe the hangar project would kick off before the ramp project. She said that they would coordinate everything and would be getting back to us, but if we had any questions to just call her.


Scott said he also ask Lindsay about getting some of the row crops back and she replied that the ALP has to be approved before that happens, so we're waiting.

Rick said based on the presentation he presented to the county board for new hangar doors, we are instructed to provide sealed bids and also include it in our budget proposal.
