#### **SHELBY COUNTY BOARD MEETING**

#### January 14, 2009 - 9:00 A.M.

The Shelby County Board met on Wednesday, January 14, 2009, at 9:00 A.M. at the Courthouse in Shelbyville, Illinois.

Chairman Paul Brooks called the meeting to order and all present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk called the roll. Norma Stewart was absent. Bruce Cannon and Robert Jordan were tardy.

Minutes for the December 10, 2008 Board meeting were presented for approval.

MOTION:

Jim Warren made motion to approve the minutes of the December 10, 2008 Board meeting as presented.

John "Jack" Roessler seconded the motion.

VOTE:

All voted aye by voice and the motion carried.

E. C. Eberspacher, Attorney for the Illinois Landowners Association (ILA), addressed the Board. Mr. Eberspacher requested an Adhoc Committee be appointed and the same will be requested from the Illinois Landowners Association. The Board Committee will consist of Paul Brooks, as Chairman, and two other County Board members along with Allan Lollie, State's Attorney, to further discuss a way to deal with the problems caused by the position taken by BPI and to find common ground for a "win-win resolution" to their respective needs.

Ending his report, Mr. Spesard gave the Board some highlights and updates on the work in the County Highway Department. The Highway Department's Annual Report was presented and briefly highlighted by Mr. Spesard. Board member Barbara Bennett commended Mr. Spesard for his grant writing abilities and for obtaining grants on behalf of the Highway Department. It was further noted that Mr. Spesard has prepared a list of projects to be included in Shelby County's stimulus package.






