SHELBY COUNTY BOARD MEETING

May 12, 2010 – 9:00 A.M.

The Shelby County Board met on Wednesday, May 12, 2010, at 9:00 A.M. at the Courthouse in Shelbyville, Illinois.

Chairman Brooks called the meeting to order and all present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk called the roll. There were no absentees.

Minutes for the April 14, 2010 Board meeting were presented for approval.

MOTION: Norma Stewart made motion to approve the minutes of the April 14, 2010 Board meeting as presented.
Fred Doerner seconded the motion.

VOTE: All voted aye by voice and the motion carried.

County Clerk Kathy A. Lantz requested Board approval of a Resolution to certify all Vital Records in the custody of the Clerk's office. Currently, copies of death and marriage records prior to 1916 are provided to the public uncertified, if so requested.

MOTION: Richard Reynolds made motion to approve the Resolution to certify all Vital Records in the custody of the Clerk's office as presented.
Glenn R. "Dick" Clark seconded the motion.

VOTE: All voted aye by voice and the motion carried.

County Highway Engineer Alan Spesard presented a Resolution to vacate a portion of the old road right-of-way located along County Highway #11 (Mode Road). The County Board has authority to vacate the land by Resolution. There is a survey of the land involved which will be recorded in the Courthouse after the Resolution is passed. The owner of the property abutting the highway vacation would retain ownership of this property.

MOTION: Robert Behl made motion to approve the Resolution to vacate a portion of the old road right-of-way located along County Highway #11 (Mode Road) as presented.
Robin Robertson seconded the motion.

VOTE: All voted aye by voice and the motion carried.

Mr. Spesard continued with his highway report by presenting for approval the Resolution awarding Dunn Company, low bidder, the contract for the Stewardson/Mode Road Resurfacing Project, Section 09-00272-00-RS for \$832,800.65. The project estimate was \$785,213.00. A grant for \$749,000.00 was received for this project. The balance of the project not paid by the grant will be paid from reserve funds in the highway department's next fiscal year budget.

MOTION: Dale Wetherell made motion to approve the Resolution to award the Stewardson/Mode Road Resurfacing Project to Dunn Company for \$832,800.65 as presented.
Don Strohl seconded the motion.

VOTE: All voted aye by voice and the motion carried.

At this time, Mr. Spesard presented a request for approval of a Petition to replace a pipe culvert over the unnamed tributary where the same is crossed by the highway TR 354 at a point near the NE ¼, SE ¼, Section 1, T9N, and R5E on the Sigel and Prairie Township line. Estimated cost to replace is \$4,000.00. Cost share is 50 % County and 50 % to be shared between Sigel and Prairie Townships.

MOTION: Dale Wetherell made motion to approve the Petition to replace a culvert on the Sigel and Prairie Township line at an estimated cost of \$4,000.00 as presented.
Kay Kearney seconded the motion.

VOTE: All voted aye by voice and the motion carried.

Ending his report, Mr. Spesard gave the Board some updates on the work in the County Highway Department. Construction has started on the Tower Hill Village Road Project and is ahead of schedule. Three bridges, one in Rose, Dry Point and Tower Hill Townships, will be on the June 11th State letting. Three railroad crossing approach projects, one in Shelbyville Township and two in Sigel Township, will begin in June. The Highway Department will begin making cold mix on May 19th for the county as well as for townships this year. Mr. Spesard said they expect to make 2,900 ton, the most they have ever made. The department's spring highway commissioner's conference held May 7th was well attended.

Zoning Administrator Dennis Harris updated the Board on the activities of the Zoning office and highlighted the Zoning monthly report. There will be a Special Exception considered this month. With regret, Chairman Brooks informed the Board that Mr. Harris had resigned the Zoning Administrator position effective this month. Chairman Brooks stated that Mr. Harris would be hard to replace and that he has done a good job.

Shelby County Board Meeting
May 12, 2010

Cristy Pullen, ESDA Director, updated the Board on the activities of the ESDA office. Mrs. Pullen stated the County's Emergency Operation Plan has been submitted to the Regional office for approval and there is no indication that there are any problems with the plan. Mrs. Pullen informed the Board that she is resigning as ESDA Director effective May 28th. Anyone wishing information concerning the time involved for the position after accreditation may contact Mrs. Pullen. Chairman Brooks noted his regret of Mrs. Pullen's resignation and stated she has done a great job for us.

Chairman Brooks called for Committee Reports.

Public Buildings Committee Chairman, Jim Warren, requested an update on the grant applications for the Courthouse. Mr. Barr stated that they could apply in June for the grants. Other funding sources were discussed and are being researched.

Chairman Brooks stated that the Treasurer's office requested that he discuss with the Board direct deposit banking. A large majority of employees have requested this. Shelby County State Bank requests copies of the minutes where the action was approved by the Board. Treasurer Debra Page said they would like to offer this to the employees. Board members may participate. Mrs. Page needs a voided check from those wanting to participate.

MOTION: Norma Stewart made motion to give authority to Treasurer Debra Page to implement direct deposit with Shelby County State Bank; and, to add Michele Campbell as an authorized agent on the account along with the Treasurer. Participation in the program is to be voluntary.

Dale Wetherell seconded the motion.
VOTE: All voted aye by voice and the motion carried.

Chairman Brooks requested the following appointments:

Cowden Fire Protection District reappoints Kyle Dunaway, Trustee

Stewardson Fire Protection District reappoints Larry Syfert and Marvin Debolt, Trustees

Strasburg Fire Protection District reappoints Travis Dollarhide, Trustee

MOTION: Richard Hayden made motion to approve the Chairman's appointments as requested.

Glenn R. "Dick" Clark seconded the motion.
VOTE: All voted aye by voice and the motion carried.

Under correspondence, Chairman Brooks said that thank you notes were received from the Francis Evans Family (Barbara Bennett's father) and the Jean Amling Family (Rob Amling's mother) for the memorials given at the time of their passing. Senator Dale Righter sent a note thanking Chairman Brooks and the Board for speaking out against the Governor's reduction of local government distributive funds.

Chairman Brooks called for Public Body Comment.

Robert Behl stated he didn't want to accept the resignations of Mr. Harris and Mrs. Pullen and that in the past they have made motions to accept resignations.

MOTION: Robert Behl made motion to accept the resignations of Mr. Harris and Mrs. Pullen.


Glenn R. "Dick" Clark seconded the motion.
VOTE: All voted aye by voice and the motion carried.

Discussion followed. The ESDA & Zoning Committees will meet regarding filing the positions.

There was no further business to come before the Shelby County Board.

MOTION: Glenn R. "Dick" Clark made motion to assess mileage and per diem for the May meetings, to pay the bills and payroll as approved by the Committees and adjourn until the next regular meeting to be held on June 9, 2010.

Don Strohl seconded the motion.
VOTE: All voted aye by voice, motion carried and the meeting was adjourned at 9:35 A.M.



THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Shelby County Board that the above described right-of-way be vacated.

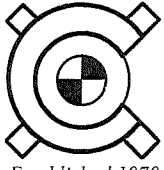

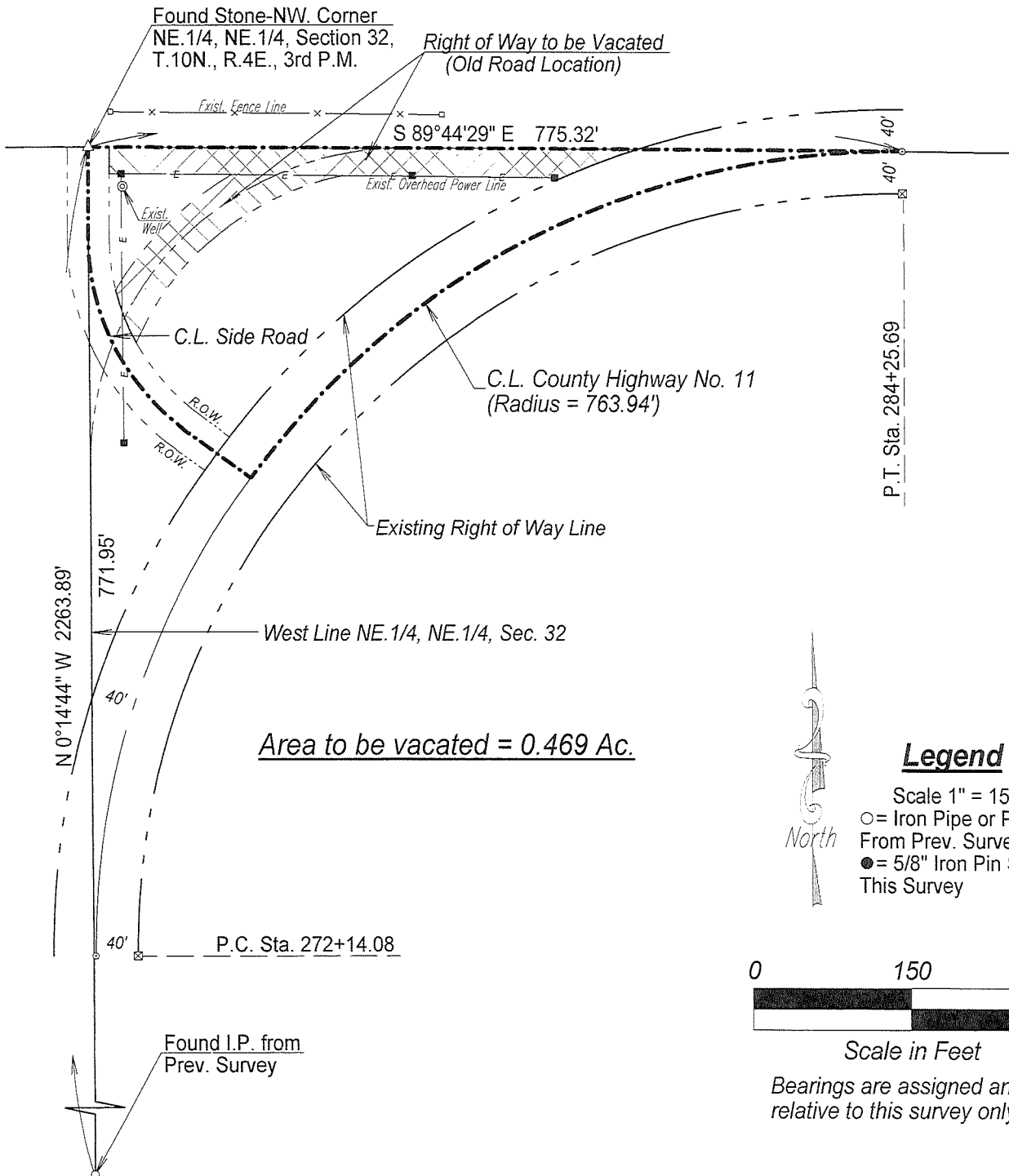

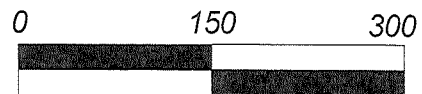

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEE
FOR THE COWDEN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the COWDEN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT is a duly organized and operating fire protection district contained entirely within the County of Shelby, State of Illinois, but not wholly within a single township or municipality, and


WHEREAS, 70 ILCS 705/4 (3), provides that the trustees for a fire protection district so situated shall be appointed by the presiding officer of the County Board with the advice and consent of the County Board, and

WHEREAS, there have been trustees appointed for the said fire protection district and the present term of KYLE DUNAWAY will expire on the first Monday OF THIS YEAR, and he has consented to serve another term, and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the County Board has appointed KYLE DUNAWAY to serve a full three year term as trustee commencing the first Monday in May, 2010, and directed that, prior to that time, he file with the Shelby County Circuit Clerk his bond in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) with two individual sureties,
