#### SHELBY COUNTY BOARD MEETING

#### October 14, 2015 - 9:00 A.M.

The Shelby County Board met on Wednesday, October 14, 2015, at 9:00 A.M. at the Courthouse in Shelbyville, Illinois.

Chairman David Cruitt called the meeting to order. Father Don Wolford of the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Shelbyville gave the prayer and all present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

County Clerk Jessica Fox called the roll.

Minutes for the September 9, 2015 board meeting were presented for approval. Mulholland made motion to approve the minutes as presented. Clark seconded said motion, which passed by voice vote (21 yes, 0 no).

EMA Coordinator and Sheriff Don Koonce addressed the Board requesting approval for a Resolution to consolidate with Christian County to create a new Joint Emergency Telephone System Board to provide enhanced 9-1-1 services to Shelby County in the future. The Shelby County 911 Ad hock Committee, which had overseen the Emergency Addressing Project, had met to discuss and review this agreement and also was in support of consolidating with Christian County.

Wetherell made motion to approve the Resolution as presented. Hayden seconded said motion, which passed by voice vote (21 yes, 0 no). (Resolution attached to these minutes).

Chairman Cruitt next presented for approval a franchise authority extension agreement with Newwave Communications. Discussion was held in regards to what this extension covered. Barr made motion to table the approval of the extension agreement until more information is obtained. Woodall seconded motion to table, which passed by voice vote (20 yes, 1 nay, Mulholland voting no).

At this time Chairman Cruitt called for the Highway Engineer's report,

Alan Spesard, County Highway Engineer, addressed the Board to request approval for 2 petitions and give some updates on Highway Department projects. Both petitions were from the Ridge Township Highway Commissioner. The first request is to replace a culvert 2 miles southeast of Westervelt. Estimated costs are \$3500.00 and will be shared 50/50 between the County and Township.

Woodall made motion to approve the petition to replace the culvert. Wetherell seconded said motion, which passed by voice vote (21 yes, 0 no). (Petition attached to these minutes).

The next petition presented was to replace a concrete box culvert ½ mile south of Henton in Ridge Township at a cost of \$8,000.00 to be shared 50/50 between the County and the Township. Clark made motion to approve the petition to replace the concrete box culvert. Mulholland seconded said motion, which passed by voice vote (21 yes, 0 no). (Petition attached to these minutes).

Continuing with updates, Spesard reported that due to the State budget crisis, monthly MFT allotments still have not been released to the Townships or Counties. However various programs funded from MFT monies have been released. Those include needy township, county consolidated needy money and the township bridge program funds. Spesard reported last month that the Tower Hill railroad crossing approach had been completed and the road opened. Shortly after, the railroad contractor installing the signal lights and gates damaged the road and it had to be closed for repair. That road has once again been opened and the County will be reimbursed for the road repair. Construction is continuing on the 2 closed bridges in Richland Township just west of Strasburg and Spesard hopes that he can report these bridges are open at the next board meeting. Spesard will be hosting the semi-annual Highway Commissioner's Educational Conference on November 6 at the Highway Department.

Chairman Cruitt called for committee reports. (Committee reports are attached to these minutes). Reports were given and items presented for follow-up or for public awareness are as follows:

Airport Committee Member Jordan – The committee is looking for a member to replace Jim Looft who resigned from the Airport and Landing Fields Commission. Please give names of persons to replace Looft to either Cannon or Cruitt.

There were no chairman updates, correspondence or appointments for the month.

There was no further business to come before the Shelby County Board.

Clark made motion to assess mileage and per diem for the October meetings, to pay the bills/payroll as approved by the committees and adjourn until the next regular meeting to be held on November 12, 2015. Bennett seconded said motion, which passed by voice vote (21 yes, 0 no) and the meeting was adjourned at 9:34 A.M.

Whereas, the Shelby County Board has found and declared that it is in the public interest to shorten the time required for a citizen to request and receive emergency aid; and

Whereas, the Illinois General Assembly has passed Public Act 99-6 amending the Emergency Telephone System Act; and

Whereas, the Emergency Telephone System Act, 50 ILCS 750/15.4a(a)(7), states that "The corporate authorities of each county that has no 9-1-1 service as of January 1, 2016 shall provide enhanced 9-1-1 wireline and wireless enhanced 9-1-1 service for that county by either (i) entering into an intergovernmental agreement with an existing Emergency Telephone System Board to create a new Joint Emergency Telephone System Board, or (ii) entering into an intergovernmental agreement with the corporate authorities that have created an existing Joint Emergency Telephone System Board."; and

Whereas, Shelby County Public Safety Officials have advised the Shelby County Board that a consolidation with Christian County to create a new Joint Emergency Telephone System Board through an intergovernmental agreement is in the best interest of the citizens of Shelby County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the County Board of Shelby County assembled this 14th day of October, 2015, that the Chairman of Shelby County is hereby authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with Christian County to form a new Joint Emergency Telephone System Board.





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# SHELBY COUNTY AIRPORT and LANDING FIELD COMMISSION MINUTES OF MEETING August 3, 2015

Rick Brown calls the meeting to order.

Members present at meeting:

Commissioners--Jim Looft, Rick Brown and Steve Wempen, Jeff Green, John Hall County Board Members--Bruce Cannon, Bob Simpson, Bob Jordan Airport Manager--Scott Jefson Others Present--Mayor Jeff Johnson

The minutes were read by all. Rick makes a motion to approve the minutes. It was seconded by Jeff and was approved by all saying aye.

The Treasurer's report was read by all. Jeff makes a motion to approve the Treasurers Report. It was seconded by Rick and was approved by all saying aye.

Mayor Jeff Johnson was present and talked some about the business districts expansion to the west. Jeff also said he knows how important the airport is for the area and was there for support and to offer their assistance if needed. Jeff stayed for the entire meeting.

#### Managers Report

Finished construction on the project and that Hanson's was sending someone out to take core samples of the asphalt from specific locations. We got a free sidewalk from the main hangar to the new sidewalk because they needed to repair some damage they had done to the end of it. They uncovered a cleanout line and not sure where it goes, and painted it orange. Going to check with the schools landscaping class about doing some landscaping in the three areas between the buildings to eliminate the need to mow it. Had a Pipistrel (powered glider) crash next to the airfield from carburetor icing. Working with the FAA and the insurance company at present and that it is tore down and in the main hangar. While at Oshkosh, Scott said he found the US representative for Pipistrel and after Oshkosh he drove down and tore it down. After taking pictures and communicating with the factory, the plane is repairable.

Jeff Green asks about the airports liability and Scott said it was all pilot error and no liability to the airport. There were no injuries.

Went and got a load of pea gravel and replace some around several lights and also cleaned out under the beacon and put a few inches pea gravel there so it doesn't need mowed.

Also redid three of the four grass thresholds. The threshold for runway 4 is still undecided. Also blacked out five parking spaces to take care of the line-of-sight issue with runway 4 and get it's threshold moved back.

Was called over to IHI when engineer from Hanson's was here to discussed flight patterns, distances and/or anything that could be an issue with IHI building a two storey office building across the highway and not build on the airport. There were no issues.

Got a call from Roger Sweeney and yellow tractor is finished, so went and picked it up. Had to get parts from Tony's Welding for the big mower. Using up some dirt on some low spots out front and the rest at the end of the runway by the highway. Dunkett's are coming out Thursday to clean the carpets now the project is done. Monticello Glider Club is looking for a new home because the airport is closing, so they're looking for a new home. They have a building they would want to move and are also looking at Coles County Airport.

#### End of Managers report

Jim Looft mentions having a form to fill out to get the fuel farm project started. Jim also mentions needing to talk to Scott Paden at IDOT about the available money and advertising for a consultant. A lengthy discussion followed on the matter.





Scott also mentions the state approved our runway to 18,500 lbs. per wheel.

Jim mentions looking into websites and had not had any luck.

Bruce asks about extending the runway and jim mentions that the state would like to see that. Some discussion followed on the matter.



MINUTES APPROVED: Alan Zuber moved to approve minutes from March 2, 2015 meeting. Second was made by Bibby Appleby and unanimously approved by voice vote.

REGIONAL SUPERINTENDENT REPORTS: Report of Official Acts and Quarterly Funds Report were reviewed and discussed. Dr. Mattingly announced that a CD had been set up at First Mid for the Major Maintenance Fund followed by a brief report on RSSP funding campaign that resulted in legislation to change the formula that landed in rules.

ASS'T REGIONAL SUPT. REPORT: Kyle Thompson reported on legislative issues relating to education and introduced ROE#11 new website.

BUDGET: Dr. Mattingly explained that ROE Youth Services Programs were cut an additional \$15373 because of the Governors "Good Friday" reductions. During the month of May, all ROE programs suspended purchase of supplies and travel reimbursements.





A very short meeting was held with Kay Kearney speaking briefly of the current negotiations with the FOP union.


