

**NOTICE OF EARLY VOTING SCHEDULE  
MARCH 19, 2024 – GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION**

An Early Voter is an individual that is already properly and correctly registered to vote in Shelby County and wishes to vote in-person prior to Election Day. Identification is not required to cast an Early Vote. Because this is a Primary Election, all voters must declare party preference to obtain a ballot with candidates. The only exception is in precincts which have a proposition on the ballot. Then, a non-partisan ballot can be requested which contains only that proposition. The voter must reside within the district asking the question.

Public Notice is hereby given that Early Voting for the General Primary Election, which includes all Shelby County Precincts, will be conducted at the Office of the Shelby County Clerk, Jessica Fox, in the County Courthouse, 301 E. Main Street, Second Floor in Shelbyville, beginning on Thursday, February 8, 2024.

Regular office hours are weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.; except the Courthouse will be closed on February 12 and February 19 to observe holidays. The County Clerk's office will be open for Early Voting on Saturday, March 16 from 9:00 a.m. to Noon. Early Voting will end on Monday, March 18 at 4:00 p.m.

Any voters with questions are urged to call the Shelby County Clerk's Office at 217-774-4421. Any vote cast is final and may not be revoked. An early voter is not eligible to cast a vote on Election Day.
