hereinafter termed the Applicant, request permission and authority to do certain work herein described on the right-of-way of the County Highway in Shelby County, Illinois known as:

The work's location and details are described on the attached sketches and/or as follows:

All work shall be in accordance with the attached details/sketches. Modifications will require approval from the County Engineer.

The applicant shall be responsible for all damages and assume all liabilities for construction, location, operation and maintenance of said work.

A copy of this permit shall be in the possession of the Construction Foreman on the job site for inspection by the County Highway personnel.

Right-of-Way (R.O.W.): It is the applicant's responsibility to establish the correct property line and R.O.W. line locations. This permit only grants applicant permission and authority to do the work herein described on the R.O.W. of County Highways. Approval of this permit does not relieve the applicant of its responsibility to obtain other approvals and/or easements within the County Highway R.O.W. that is required by law.

It is understood that the work authorized by this permit shall be completed within 1 year after the date this permit is approved, otherwise the permit becomes null and void.

All surfaces, if necessary, shall be restored to original condition according to I.D.O.T. Road and Bridge current addition specifications. The proposed work shall be located and constructed to the satisfaction of the County Engineer or his duly authorized representative. No open trenches immediately adjacent to pavement are allowed to be left open overnight.

The applicant shall at all times conduct the work in such a manner to minimize hazards to vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Traffic controls and work site protection shall be in accordance with the applicable requirements of Chapter 6 (Traffic Controls for Highway Construction and Maintenance Operations) of the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways. Work shall be done only during daylight hours.

No excavation within 5 feet from edge of roadway shoulder will be permitted. Lines shall be buried at least 30 inches below existing ground line and within 5 feet from edge of R.O.W. where practicable. Lines below roadway shall be bored at a depth no less than 30 inches below the ditch flow line elevation. Bore Pit Excavation shall be within 5 feet from edge of R.O.W. where practicable.

If future construction and/or maintenance performed by the County requires the relocation of the utility, it shall be done at the applicant's expense within 90 days of written notification.
